The Board of Directors of the Company at their meeting held on today i.e. May 6, 2022, considered, approved and recommended the following:

Financial Results:

The Audited Standalone and Consolidated Financial Results of the Company for the quarter and financial year ended March 31, 2022, ("financial statements") have been approved by the Board of Directors. In this regard, we enclose herewith the Audited Standalone and Consolidated Financial Statements of the Company for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2022, and also the Auditor's Report for the year ended March 31, 2022, issued with an unmodified opinion on the financial statements by M/s. Price Waterhouse Chartered Accountants LLP (Firm Registration No. 012754N/N500016), Statutory Auditors of the Company.

The detailed Standalone and Consolidated Financial Results of the Company would be available on the website of the Company, www.grindwellnorton.co.in.

Appointment of Statutory Auditor:

Based on the recommendation of the Audit Committee, the Board at its meeting held today, recommended the appointment of M/s. Kalyaniwalla & Mistry LLP, Chartered Accountants (Firm Registration No. 104607W/W100166), as the Statutory Auditors of the Company for a period of five (5) consecutive years from the conclusion of the 72nd AGM of the Company until the conclusion of the 77th AGM of the Company, subject to the approval of the Members at the ensuing AGM of the Company, in place of M/s. Price Waterhouse Chartered Accountants LLP (Firm Registration No. 012754N/N500016), whose term completes as the Statutory Auditors of the Company at the conclusion of the ensuing AGM of the Company.

Execution of Share Purchase Agreement:

The Board approved the execution of the Share Purchase Agreement ("SPA") with the existing shareholders of PRS Permacel Private Limited for the acquisition of the 100% equity shares for a consideration of Rs. 1220 Million (subject to closing adjustment). Pursuant to the execution of the said SPA, PRS Permacel Private Limited will become a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company. Further details pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, disclosed within the stipulated timeframe.

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Dividend:

The Board of Directors have recommended a dividend of Rs. 12/- per equity share (240%) of Rs. 5/-each for the financial year 2021-22, subject to the approval of the Members at the ensuing AGM of the Company to be held on Friday, July 29, 2022. The Dividend, if approved shall be paid/dispatched on the fourth day from the conclusion of 72nd AGM of the Company, subject to the approval of the Members of the Company.

Book Closure:

The Register of Members and Share Transfer Books of the Company will remain closed from Thursday, July 21, 2022 to Friday, July 29, 2022, (both days inclusive) for the purpose of the AGM and for the payment of dividend, subject to the approval of the Members at the ensuing AGM of the Company.

Annual General Meeting:

The 72nd Annual General Meeting of the Company will be held on Friday, July 29, 2022.

The Board Meeting commenced at 2:30 p.m. IST and concluded at 4:15 p.m. IST.

The consolidated financial results includes the unaudited financial statements of one subsidiary, whose financial statements reflect total assets of Rs. 5,489 lakhs and net assets of Rs. 3,854 lakhs as at March 31, 2022, total revenue of Rs. 3,353 lakhs, total net loss after tax of Rs. 190 lakhs, and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 190 lakhs and cash inflow (net) of Rs. 229 lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2022, as considered in the consolidated financial results. The consolidated financial statements also include the Group's share of net profit after tax of Rs. Nil and total comprehensive income of Rs. Nil in respect of one associate, whose financial statements has not been audited by us. These financial statements are unaudited and have been furnished to us by the Management and our opinion on the consolidated financial results, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of this subsidiary and associate, is based solely on such unaudited financial statements. In our opinion and according to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these financial statements are not material to the Group.

Our opinion on the consolidated Financial Results is not modified in respect of the above matters with respect to our reliance on the work done and the reports of the other auditor and the Financial information certified by the Management.

13. The Financial Results include the results for the quarter ended March 31, 2022, being the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published unaudited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the current financial year, which are neither subject to limited review nor audited by us.
