(The other income during previous financial year ended March 31, 2021 includes Rs.661.70 lakhs, as dividend income from Associate company).
- 4 The Company has considered the possible effects that may arise out of the still unfolding COVID-19 pandersic on the Company's operations and the carrying amounts of property, plant & equipment, inventories, trade receivables, etc. Based on the current estimates, the Company does not expect any significant impact on such carrying values. The impact of COVID-19 on the Company's financial statements may differ from that estimated as at the date of approval of the Financial Results.
- The Indian Parliament has approved the Code on Social Security 2020, relating to employee benefits during employeement and post-employment benefits, which would impact the contributions by the Company towards Providend Fund and Graturity. The Ministry of Labour and Employment has released draft rules for the Code on Social Security. 2020 on November 13, 2020, and has invited suggestions from stakeholders which are under active consideration by the Ministry. Emphasis of Matter

6. We draw attention to Note 4 to the Statement, which describes the uncertainties and the impact of Covid-19 pandemic on the Group's operations, recoverability of receivables and other assets and management's evaluation of the future performance of the Group. In view of the uncertain economic environment, a definitive assessment of the impact on the subsequent periods is dependent upon circumstances as they evolve.

Our conclusion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Other Matters

7. We did not review the consolidated financial results of Associate company namely Isgec Heavy Engineering Limited and its subsidiary & associate companies, whose interim financial information/ financial results reflects total revenues of Rs.1,37,611/- lakhs and Rs.2,50,761/- lakhs, total net profit after tax of Rs.1,007/- lakhs and Rs.2,384/- lakhs and total comprehensive income of Rs.812/- lakhs and Rs.2135/- lakhs, for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2021, respectively, and cash outflows (net) of Rs.1,540/- Lakhs for the half year ended September 30, 2021. The Consolidated financial results include the Share in consolidated profit of Associate company as Rs. 453.15/- lakhs and Rs.1072.80/-lakhs for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2021, respectively considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results Rs. The interim financial information/ financial results of the Isgec Heavy Engineering Limited and its subsidiary and associate companies have been reviewed by other auditor, whose report has been furnished to us by the management and our conclusion on the statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of it is solely based on the report of other auditor and procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above. Our conclusion on statement is not modified in respect of above matter.

Based on the current estimates, the Group does not expect any significant impact on such carrying values. The impact of COVID-19 on the Group's financial statements may differ from that estimated as at the date of approval of the Consolidated Financial Results.
- The Indian Parliament has approved the Code on Social Security 2020, relating to employee benefits during employement and post-employment benefits, which would impact the contributions by the Group towards Providend Fund and Graturity. The Ministry of Labour and Employment has released draft rules for the Code on Social Security, 2020 on November 13, 2020, and has invited suggestions from stakeholders which are under active consideration by the Ministry.
