Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the other auditor and unaudited financial statement furnished by management referred to in paragraph 6 & 7 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') specified under section 133 of the Companies Act 2013, as amended, read with relevant rules there under and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

Other Matters

6. We did not review the interim financial statements of the subsidiary, CAMS Financial Information Services Private Limited, included in the unaudited consolidated financial results, whose interim financial statements reflect total revenue of Rs. 5.48 Lakhs and Rs. 13.21 Lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2022 respectively, total net loss after tax of Rs. 71.25 Lakhs and 266.76 Lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2022 respectively and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 69.57 Lakhs and 261.13 Lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2022 respectively as considered in the unaudited consolidated financial results. These interim financial statements have been reviewed by other auditors whose report have been furnished to us by the management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of the subsidiary, is based solely on the reports of the other auditor and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.

7. We did not review the interim financial statements of the subsidiary, Sterling Software (Deutschland) GMBH (liquidated on November 15, 2022) included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial statements reflect total revenue of Rs. Nil for the period from 1st October 2022 to 15th November 2022 and Year to date ended 15th November, 2022, total net loss after tax of Rs. 0.02 Lakhs and Rs. 0.17 Lakhs for the period from 1st October 2022 to 15th November 2022 and Year to date ended 15th November, 2022 respectively, and total comprehensive gain of Rs. 0.06 Lakhs for the period from 1st October 2022 to 15th November 2022 and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 0.14 Lakhs for the Year to date ended 15th November, 2022 as considered in the unaudited consolidated financial results. These interim financial results are unaudited and have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of the subsidiary, is based solely on such unaudited financial statements and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above. In our opinion and according to the explanation given to us by the Management, these financial statements are not material to the Group.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.
