The Company has received Show Cause cum Demand notices ("SCNs") from the Department of Telecommunications ("DOT"), Government of India for the financial years 2007-08 and for the financial years 2009-10 to 2012-13 towards ISP license fees aggregating to Rs. 22.71 Crores which includes penalty and interest thereon upto the respective dates of the notice (March 31, 2020: for the financial years 2007-08 and 2009-10 aggregating to Rs.7.87 Crores). The Company has responded to DOT contesting their inclusion of Cable TV revenue in arriving at Adjusted Gross Revenue "AGR" for calculation of License Fee payable by the Company under the ISP License in these SCNs. Based on the opinion of legal expert, the Company is confident that it has good grounds on merit to defend itself in the above matter. Accordingly, the Company is of the view that no provision is necessary in respect of the aforesaid matter.



- 2. The financial figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2020 and March 31, 2021 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year ended on March 31, 2020 and March 31, 2021 respectively and the published year to date unaudited figures upto the third quarter of the year ended March 31, 2020 and March 31, 2021 respectively.
- 3. These results have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable. The figures for the corresponding periods have been regrouped, wherever necessary.
- 4. As the Company's business activity falls within a single business segment in terms of Ind AS 108 on "Operating Segments', the financial results are reflective of the information required by Ind AS 108.
- 5. The Company has received Show Cause cum Demand notices ("SCNs") from the Department of Telecommunications ("DOT"), Government of India for the financial years 2007-08 and for the financial years 2009-10 to 2012-13 towards ISP license fees aggregating to Rs. 22.71 Crores which includes penalty and interest thereon upto the respective dates of the notice (March 31, 2020: for the financial years 2007-08 and 2009-10 aggregating to Rs.7.87 Crores). The Company has responded to DOT contesting their inclusion of Cable TV revenue in arriving at Adjusted Gross Revenue "AGR" for calculation of License Fee payable by the Company under the ISP License in these SCNs. Based on the opinion of legal expert, the Company is confident that it has good grounds on merit to defend itself in the above matter. Accordingly, the Company is of the view that no provision is necessary in respect of the aforesaid matter.
