Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Financial Statements of Quarterly and year to date financial results of M/s. Jhaveri Credits and Capital Limited ("the Company"), for the quarter ended 31st March 2022 and for the year to date results for the period 01-04-2021 to 31-03-2022, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("the Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our knowledge and information as well as according to the explanations provided to us, the aforesaid Statements:
