- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Standalone Unaudited Financial Results of Talbros Automotive Components Limited ("the Company") for the quarter ended September 30, 2021 and year to date from April 1, 2021 to September 30, 2021 ("the Statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended.

- The Company's operations and financial results for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2021 were initially impacted by the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic and the consequent series of lockdowns announced by the Government of India due to which the operations were disrupted in some part of first quarter and gradually resumed with requisite precautions and then continued normally. The results for the quarter and half ended September 30, 2021 are therefore not comparable with those for the previous period. The Company has considered the possible effects that may results from this pandemic on the carrying amounts of property, plant and equipment, investment, inventories, receivables and other current assets. The Company expects the carrying amount of these assets will be recovered and no material adjustment required in the financial statement. The Company will continue to closely monitor any material changes to future economic conditions.
- 5 In line with the provisions of Ind AS 108 Operating Segments and on the basis the review of operations being done by the senior management, the operations of the Company fall under Auto Components & Parts business, which is considered to be the only reportable segment by the management.
