U'khand CM Slept For 36 Hrs, Did Not Take Preventive Measures Ahead Of Heavy Rains: Harish

Dehradun: Former Chief Minister and Congress leader Harish Rawat on Monday slammed Uttarakhand Chief Minister

Shah," said Rawat while talking to the media. "No administration official was informed even police was informed

Dhami said that the state government will constitute a high-powered committee to monitor reconstruction work after the damage caused by incessant rainfall.

Amit Shah had conducted an aerial survey of the areas affected by the natural calamity and assessed the damage and reviewed the relief work.

"Under the leadership of Modi, we were able to reduce the loss of life and property to a great extent due to the coordination between central and state government and rescue agencies and timely warnings," he said.

I held a high-level review meeting with officials of the state and Centre over the natural calamity in Uttarakhand. Due to timely rainfall alerts, the extent of damage could be controlled. Now, the Char Dham Yatra has resumed," he said.

The death toll due to natural calamity in Uttarakhand has mounted to 72 and four people are still missing, said the Uttarakhand government on Sunday.

Also, 224 houses were damaged in rain-related incidents.—ANI

"There is no water tankers or cleaning facility available in the flood-affected areas. The fact is that the government has failed badly," he further stated.

Dehradun: Former Chief Minister and Congress leader Harish Rawat on Tuesday claimed that several people want to join the Congress due to instability in the Uttarakhand Bharatiya Janata Party.

While talking to ANI, Rawat said that the party (Congress) will only take those who they deem worthy.

"Those who had left the party want to come back, and many from BJP also want to join Con-

gress. There is a situation of instability in BJP.



Many people (want to join Congress)... can't take so many, but those who are worthy, we will

take them," he said.

Rawat also informed that Congress will begin distributing party tickets for the Uttarakhand polls in 2022 from December, and also hinted at the possibility of the party's first candidate list for the polls in December itself.

Slamming the BJP government in the state for taking credit for the reconstruction work of Kedarnath that began during his tenure, Rawat said all the works began there during his tenure but now BJP was taking credit for those works.

Rawat had also slammed Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami for not taking preventive measures despite Union Home Minister Amit Shah inquiring about the preparedness of the state to deal with incessant rains.

MHA To Send Central Teams To Uttarakhand, Kerala Soon

New Delhi (The Hawk): The Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) will soon send Inter-Ministerial Central Teams (IMCTs) to Kerala and Uttarakhand to assess the damage caused by heavy rain and floods to standing crops and infrastructure, officials here said on Tuesday.

The teams will visit the flood-affected areas in these two states and make on the spot assessment after which they will submit a report to the MHA, following which the Ministry will allocate Central assistance from the National Disaster Relief Fund, the officials added.

In case of Uttarakhand, the Central government had recently approved Rs 250 crore, and also an additional Rs 749.60 crore was released to the state, the officials said. The Uttarakhand government has estimated the total damage at Rs 7,000 crore and will send a report to the Centre to seek financial assistance from it.

Both states witnessed flood situation due to heavy rains and have caused substantial damage to standing crops and in-

frastructure, while West Bengal and Odisha also faced a similar situation with less damage and

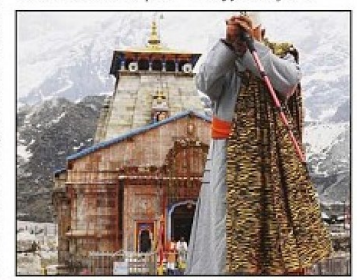

PM Modi To Visit Kedarnath On November 5

Dehradun: Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit Kedarnath on November 5, a day ahead of the closure of the Himalayan temple for winters, to inaugurate and lay the foundation stone of Kedarnath reconstruction projects worth over Rs 400 crore. It will be the second visit to the state within a month. He had visited AIIIMS, Rishikesh, on October 7 to inaugurate an oxygen plant there. Confirming Modi's visit to Kedarnath next month, Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami said besides offering prayers at the Himalayan temple, the prime minister will lay inauguration and the foundation stone of Kedarnath reconstruction projects. He will

also unveil a statue of Adi Guru Shankaracharya, Dhami said. Modi has visited Kedarnath several times after becoming prime minister in 2014. He could not come to Kedarnath last year due to the COVID-19 pan-

demic. Prime Minister Modi has been closely monitoring Kedarnath reconstruction projects. The portals of Kedarnath are scheduled to be closed for winter on November 6 on the occasion of Bhaiyya Dooj. PTI
