LIMITED REVIEW REPORT

To The Board of Directors **Meyer Apparel Limited**

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of Unaudited Financial Results of MEYER APPAREL LIMITED('the Company') for the quarter and six months ended 30th September, 2018 (the "Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, read with SEBI Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated 5th July, 2016. This statement which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principlesgenerally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.
- 2. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement (SRE) 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of the Company's personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provide less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and, accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
- 3. We draw attention that the company has incurred loss of Rs. 8.29 Lakh during the quarter (accumulated losses as at 30th September, 2018Rs. 4439.16 Lakh) resulting in to erosion of its net worth as at September 30, 2018. The ability of the Company to continue as a going concern is significantly dependent on its ability to successfully fund its operating and capital funding requirements. The management in view of its Business plans is confident of generating cash flows to fund the operating and capital requirements of the Company. Accordingly, these statements have been prepared on a going concern basis. Our report is not qualified in respect of this matter.



4. Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that caused us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principals laid down in the applicable Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') specified under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with relevant rules issued there and other recognised accounting practices and policies generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with SEBI Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated 5th July, 2016, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

The Company is in appeal against the Customs duty demand for Rs.1282 lakh pertaining to the year 1994-95 before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the matter is pending with the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The custom duty demand liability and interest liability thereon has been provided in the account books in the financial year 2015-16. Final liability would be determined on the disposal of the appeal by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- 4. The Company is in appeal against the demand for interest and damages by Commissioner, Employee Provident Fund for Rs. 4.09 lakh before the Hon'ble EPFAT, New Delhi
- 5. The Company has only one business segment i.e. manufacturing and dealing in Readymade Garments/Textile. Further, the Company has traded only in India and accordingly there is no reportable geographical segment.
- 6. The figures for the corresponding period of the previous year have been regrouped/rearranged, and/or recast, wherever required.
