- We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited standalone financial results
 of Greycells Education Limited, (the 'Company') for the quarter ended 30th June 2018
 together with the notes thereon ("the Statement"). The statement has been prepared by the
 Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations
 and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, and SEBI Circular dated 5th July, 2016.
- 2. This Statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited consolidated financial results of Greycells Education Limited ('the Holding Company' or 'the Company'), its subsidiary and its jointly controlled entity (the Company, its subsidiary and its jointly controlled entity constitute 'the Group') except for as stated in paragraph 7 and 8 below, for the quarter ended 30th June, 2018 together with the notes thereon ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Holding Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligation & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- 2. This Statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors of the Company. Further, the Management is also responsible to ensure that the accounting policies used in preparation of this Statement are in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (IND AS) prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410- 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity' issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement.

- 5. No impairment testing has been done by the management to the goodwill arising on consolidation and hence, we are unable to comment whether any such impairment provisioning is required.
- 6. The Statement includes the results of the following entities:

EMDI (Overseas) FZ LLC - Subsidiary EMDI Wedding Academy LLP – Jointly Controlled Entity

7. The financial statements of the subsidiary - EMDI (Overseas) FZ LLC have been reviewed by other auditor whose report has been furnished to us and our opinion, in so far as it relates to the amounts included in respect of this subsidiary, is based solely on the report of the other auditor. These financial statements reflect total revenues of Rs. 93.95 lakhs for the quarter anded 30th June, 2018.

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- 8. The Statement also includes the Group's share of net profit of Rs. 0.20 lakh for the quarter ended 30th June, 2018, in respect of EMDI Wedding Academy LLP Jointly Controlled Entity, whose financial statements have not been reviewed by us. These financial statements are not audited nor reviewed by any other person and have been furnished to us by the Management and our opinion, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of this jointly controlled entity is based solely on such unaudited financial statements. In our opinion and according to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these financial statements are not material to the Group.
- 9. Based on our review conducted as above, subject to paragraph 5 above and based on the consideration of report of the auditor referred to in paragraph 7 above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement prepared in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other recognized accounting practices and policies has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
