### Independent's Auditor's Report of Quarterly and Year ended Financial Results

## Opinion

We have audited the accompanying financial results of M/s Sreechem Resins Ltd. ("the Company") for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2022, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid financial results:

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of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.
