#### INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON THE AUDIT OF FINANCIAL RESULTS

# TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF ADITYA SPINNERS LIMITED

#### Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Annual Financial Results of **ADITYA SPINNERS LIMITED** (the "Company"), for the three months and year ended March 31, 2023 (the Statement), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the statement:

- a. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations; and
- b. gives a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act 2013 (the "Act") read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and total comprehensive income and other financial information of the Company for the three months and year ended March 31, 2023.

#### **Basis for Opinion**
