

A copy of the aforesaid Financial Results together with Limited Review Report(s) of the Auditors is enclosed herewith.

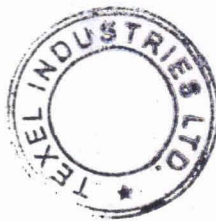

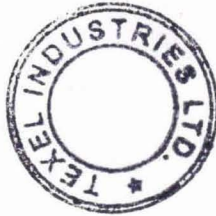

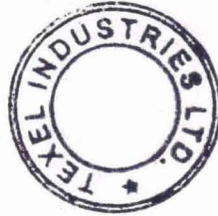
