We would like to inform you that Board Meeting of the Company was held today i.e. on Wednesday, February 03, 2021 at 04:30 P.M. at the registered office of the Company. In pursuant to Regulation 30 and 33 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, the Board has considered and approved the following:

- 1) The Un-audited standalone financial results of the Company for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2020 along with Limited Review Report thereon.

- 4) Pursuant to the provisions of Section 91 of the Companies Act,2013 read with Rule 10(1) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules ,2014 and as per Regulations 42 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosures Requirements)Regulations,2015 ,the Register of Beneficial Owners ,Register of Members and share Transfer Books of the Company will
