## SYNGENE INTERNATIONAL LIMITED

### Notes:

- The statement of unaudited standalone and consolidated financial results ("the Statements") of Syngene International Limited ('the Company') for the quarter and nine months ended 31 December 2020 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at their respective meetings held on 20 January 2021. The above Statements have been subjected to limited review by the statutory auditor of the Company. The reports of the statutory auditor are unqualified. The Statements have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- 2 The consolidated financial results include the financial results of the Company Syngene International Limited and the financial results of the wholly owned subsidiary Syngene USA Inc. The Company and the Subsidiary are collectively referred to as 'the Group'. In addition to the above, the standalone and consolidated financial results also include the financial results in respect of Syngene Employees Welfare Trust.
- Pursuant to a fire incident on 12 December 2016, certain fixed assets, inventory and other contents in one of the buildings were damaged. The Company lodged an estimate of loss with the insurance company and the survey is currently ongoing. The Company has recorded a loss of Rs. 1,057 million arising from such incident and also recognised a minimum insurance claim receivable for equivalent amounts in the respective periods till 31 March 2020. The Company has received the disbursements of Rs. 1,770 million from the insurance company against the loss till 31 March 2020. The aforementioned receivable and the disbursements from the insurance claim has been presented on a net basis as Rs. 713 million under Exceptional items in the financial results for the nine months ended 31 December 2019 and the year ended 31 March 2020. Consequential tax of Rs. 254 million is included within tax expense in standalone and consolidated financial results for the nine months ended 31 December 2019 and the year ended 31 March 2020.

In addition, the Company is in the process of determining its final claim for loss of fixed assets and Business Interruption and has accordingly not recorded any further claim arising therefrom at this stage.

- 4 The Group operates in a single segment of providing Contract Research and Manufacturing Services.
- In March 2020, the World Health Organisation declared COVID-19 to be a pandemic. The Group has adopted measures to curb the spread of infection in order to protect the health of its employees and ensure business continuity with minimal disruption.

The Group has considered internal and external information while finalizing various estimates in relation to its financial statement captions upto the date of approval of the Statements by the Board of Directors. The actual impact of the global health pandemic may be different from that which has been estimated, as the COVID -19 situation evolves in India and globally. The Group will continue to closely monitor any material changes to future economic conditions.

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited standalone financial results of Syngene International Limited for the quarter ended 31 December 2020 and year to date results for the period from 1 April 2020 to 31 December 2020 ("the Statement").
- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('Listing Regulations').
