Limited Review Report on Unaudited Quarterly Standalone Financial Results of MALLCOM (INDIA) LIMITED under Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.

To Board of Directors of MALLCOM (INDIA) LIMITED

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited standalone financial results of MALLCOM (INDIA) LIMITED ("Company") for the quarter ended 30th June 2021 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, amended ('Listing Regulations') read with SEBI Circular CIR/CFD/CMD1/44/2019 dated 29th March 2019(" the Circular). Our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries is based solely on such unreviewed/unaudited interim financial information.
