1 The above standatone unaudited financial results of the Company were reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee on 11 November 2022 and subsequently approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 11 November 2022. The review report has been filed with stock exchange and is available on the Company's website.

2 The above unaudited standalone financial results for the quarter and six months ended 30 September 2022 have been subjected to limited review by stalulory auditors of the Company. The auditors have expressed an unmodified opinion in the limited review report for the quarter and six months ended 30 September 2022. Also the figures for the quarter and six months ended 30 September 2021 were only reviewed and not subjected to audit.

- 3 These unaudited standalone financial results have been prepared in compliance with Ind AS as notified by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs and prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting pronouncements generally accepted in India, to the extent applicable.
- 4 During the quarter and six months ended 30 September 2022, the company has forfeited 3,657 equity stock options and 7,318 equity stock options, respectively, granted to employees under employees stock option schemes, on discontinuance of services of these employees. The Company has also allotted 28,913 equity shares on exercise of options during the quarter ended 30 September 2022.
- 5 API Holdings Limited, the Parent Company of Holding Company of Thyrocare Technologies Limited instituted an Employee Stock Option Plan (ESOP) to issue stock options to eligible employees of API Group with an exercise price of Rs. 1 per share. The ESOP vest over a period of one year to five years under graded vesting pattern. The eligible employees of the Company are entitled to stock options of the Parent Company under an "API Holding Limited-Employee Stock Option Plan 2020". During the quarter and six months ended 30 September 2022, the Company has recognised expenses amounting to Rs.6.65 crores, and Equity ESOP contribution reserve of similar amount, on account of grant of stock option to eligible employees of the company.

6 In accordance with Ind AS 108 'Operating Segments', segment information has been given in the consolidated financial results of the Company.

7 Previous periods' figures have been regrouped/ reclassified wherever required, to make them comparable with the figure for the current period.

4 These unaudited consolidated financial results have been prepared in compliance with Ind AS as notified by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs and prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting pronouncement generally accepted in India, to the extent applicable.

5 During the quarter and six months ended 30 September 2022, the company has forfeited 3,657 equity stock options and 7,318 equity stock options. respectively, granted to employees under employees stock option schemes, on discontinuance of services of these employees. The Company has also allotted 28,913 equity shares on exercise of options during the quarter ended 30 September 2022.
