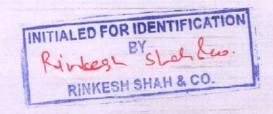

Notes to Audited Standalone Financial Results for the Quarter and Year ended March 31, 2022.

- The above Audited standalone financial results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and thereafter approved by the Board of Directors of the Company in their respective meetings held on May 25, 2022.
- The Statutory Auditors of the Company have audited the standalone financial results for the quarter and year ended March 31,2022 as per regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing obligation and disclosure requirements) Regulation 2015.
- 3. The company has migrated from NSE SME platform to the Main Board of NSE and BSE. Accordingly the Audited standalone financial results for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2022 have been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS) prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognized accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable. The company has also prepared restated financial statements for the previous years ended 31.03.21 and 31.03.20 with reconciliation statement of Profit and Equity prepared and accounting treatments as required under Ind AS 101 for the first-time adoption of Ind AS.
- 4. The figures in respect of results for the quarter ended March 31, 2022 and March 31, 2021 are the balancing figures between the Audited figures in respect of the full financial year and year to date figures up to the third quarter of the respective financial year.
- 5. The Company operates in a single segment and in line with Ind AS 108 "Operating Segments", the operation of the Company fall under "IT & IT enabled Services" Business which is considered to be the only reportable business segment.
- 6. The Parliament of India has approved the Code on Social Security, 2020 (the Code) which may impact the contributions by the Company towards provident fund, gratuity and ESIC. The Ministry of Labour and Employment has released draft rules for the Code on November 13, 2020. Final rules are yet to be notified.

- The Company will assess the impact of the Code when it comes into effect and will record related impact, if any.
