December, 2022 were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on February 14, 2023 and have been subject to limited review by the Statutory Auditors of the Company The above results have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standard (Ind-AS) as prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 3 of the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 and Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Amendment Rules, 2016.
- 2. Figures of previous periods have been regrouped and reclassified wherever necessary, to make them comparable to the current period.
- 3. The Indian Parliament has approved the Code on Social Security, 2020 which subsumes the Provident Fund and Gratuity Act and rules thereunder, The Ministry of Labour and Employment has also released draft rules thereunder on 13 November 2020, and has invited suggestion from stakeholders which are under active consideration by the Ministry. The Company will evaluate the rules assess the impact, if any, and account for the same once the rules are notified and become effective.
- 4. Tax expense includes current tax and deferred tax.
- 5. The whole organic Soyameal Manufacturing Industry in India saw a substantial fall in export to United States Of America ('USA') due to levy of Countervailing Duty and antidumping duty on produce imported from India. The Soybean Processors Association of India ('SOPA') has challenged such levy by USA before the appropriate forum and the matter is sub-judice as on date. The company also got impacted by the same and saw a decline in export turnover during the past 2-3 years, considering the same company has decided to part away with fixed assets on going concern basis, related to the manufacturing segment of the company vide resolution passed in the AGM held on 30th September, 2022.
- 6. During the quarter ended 31st December 2022 the company has incurred a loss of 1.85 Crores on sale of fixed assets relating to soya meal manufacturing plant.
