The consolidated unaudited financial results also include the share of profit of the joint venture (Al Tamman Indsil Ferro Chrome LLC) amounting to Rs.84.47 Lakhs accounted using the Equity method for the period from 01/04/2022 to 31/12/2022, which have not been audited by their auditors. The amounts and disclosures in so far as it relates to the subsidiary and joint venture, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in para 3 above.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.
