- 3 The Ind AS compliant corresponding figures in the previous period has not been subjected to review by auditors. However, the Company's management has exercised necessary due diligence to ensure that such financial results provide a true and fair virew of affairs.

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Unaudited Financial Results of Arrow Textiles Limited ("the Company") for the quarter ended June 30, 2017 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016. This Statement which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" as prescribed under Section 133 of Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued there under and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. - 2. - 3.
