Attention of the members is drawn to note no 4 of the Standalone Financial Results regarding the impact of COVID-19 on business, where the management has estimated that the future cash flows of the Company with the possible effect that may result from the COVID-19 pandemic and does not proceed any adverse impact on its ability to continue as going concern and in meeting its liabilities as and when they fall due. The actual impact of the COVID-19 pandemic may be different from that
