The Board of Directors of the Company, which has been identified as being the Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM), evaluates the Company's performance, allocate resources based on the analysis of the various performance indicators of the Company as a single unit. Accordingly, there is no other reportable segment in terms of Ind AS 108 'Operating Segments'.

(b) Consolidated:

The Group's reportable segment has been identified as business segment based on nature of products, risks, returns and the internal business reporting system as per Ind AS 108. The Group is engaged in business of Commercial Vehicle and Financial Services mainly relating to vehicle and housing financing.

- (6) The statement includes the results for the quarter ended March 31, 2023, being the balancing figure between audited figures in respect of the full financial year, and the published year to date figures of the Group / Company upto the third quarter of the previous financial year.
- (7) The Company is continuing to provide for income tax based on the old tax regime, considering the outstanding MAT credit entitlement and various deductions available to the Company under the Income Tax Act, 1961. However, the Company has applied the lower Income tax rates as provided under Section 115 BAA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 on the deferred tax assets / liabilities to the extent these are expected to be realized or settled in the future period when the Company may opt for lower tax rate and accordingly reversed net deferred tax liability of Rs. 172 crores during the quarter ended June 30, 2023. The effective tax rate would be at around 35%, but for this adjustment.
- (8) Hinduja Leyland Finance Limited (HLFL) is in the process of obtaining the relevant regulatory approvals for the proposed merger with NDL Ventures Limited (formerly known as Nxtdigital Limited). The above proposed merger was approved by the Board of Directors of HLFL vide their meeting dated November 25, 2022. NDL Ventures Limited (formerly known as Nxtdigital Limited) has its shares listed on Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) and National Stock Exchange of India Ltd (NSE).

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.

The consolidated unaudited financial results includes the consolidated interim financial information of three subsidiaries and interim financial information of nine subsidiaries and one step down subsidiary which have not been reviewed by their auditors, whose interim financial information reflect total revenue of Rs. 881.91 crores, total net profit after tax of Rs. 12.05 crores and total net comprehensive income of Rs. 13.47 crores for the quarter ended June 30, 2023, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. The consolidated unaudited financial results also includes the Group's share of net profit after tax of Rs. 1.60 crores and total net comprehensive income of Rs. 3 crores for the quarter ended June 30, 2023, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results, in respect of three associates and three joint ventures, based on their interim financial information which have not been reviewed by their auditors. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Parent's Management, these interim financial information are not material to the Group.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.
