

- 4. Non-Current financial liabilities-Borrowings of Rs. 18.73 Crores (As on March 31, 2021 Rs 21.05 Crores) include loans of Rs 13.17 Crores from Promoter. The loans from shareholder are subject to contractual and mutually agreed terms between Promoter Shareholder and the Company, from time to time and said terms may include non-interest bearing & such other applicable terms.
- 5. The audited financial results are rounded to the nearest crores, except when otherwise indicated. Amounts represented by '0' (zero) construes value less than Rupees fifty thousand.
- 6. The Government of India, on September 20, 2019, vide the Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance 2019, inserted a new section 115BAA in the Income Tax Act, 1961, which provides an option to the Company for paying Income Tax at reduced rates as per the provisions/conditions defined in the said section. - 8. There is no dilution to the basic EPS as there are no outstanding potentially dilutive shares.
- 9. The Figures for the previous period/year have been regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary, to make them comparable.
