Pursuant to implementation of the Resolution Plan, the Company has written off/derecognised or provided for impairment of its assets, based on management's estimate, to the extent not receivable/recoverable and written back/ derecognised its liabilities, based on management's estimate, to the extent not payable/extinguished/waived/cancelled to the Statement of Profit and Loss amounting to INR 15,752.20 Lakhs (net).

- Company's business relates to the providing Automatic Identification & Data Capture (AIDC)
 Solutions which in context of Indian Accounting Standards 108 (Ind AS 108) as notified under Section
 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 is considered as the only segment.
