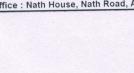

## Qualified Opinion

- 1. We have audited the accompanying standalone financial statements of Agri-Tech (India) Limited having CIN: L01110MH1993PLC073268 ("the Company"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022, the Statement of Profit and Loss (including other comprehensive income), Statement of Cash Flows and Statement of Changes in Equity for the year then ended, and notes to financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.
- 2. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the aforesaid standalone financial statements give the information required by the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act') in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under section 133 of the Act read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015, as amended ("Ind AS") and the other accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the state of affairs of the Company as at 31st March 2022 and its loss (financial performance including other comprehensive income), the changes in equity and its cash flows for the year ended on that date.

# Basis for Qualified Opinion

3. We conducted our audit in accordance with Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Act. Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements under the provisions of the Act and the rules there under, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the ICAI's Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

# 4. Qualification

In respect of inter-corporate Loans / Advances, prima-facie, the company has not complied with the provisions of section 186 of the Act, in as much as these are interest free loans granted to seven parties. (Refer Note No. 35 of notes on financial statements). Maximum amount outstanding during the year Rs. 9000.63 Lakhs and amount outstanding as at the close of the year is Rs. 7890.70 Lakhs.



## Emphasis of the Matter

5. Your attention is invited to note no 4(b) regarding mis-appropriation of 4,00,000 Equity Shares of Nath Biogenes (India) Limited (NBIL) pledged by the company to secure the borrowings in the previous year by charging an uncovered loss of Rs. 257.70 Lakhs to the statement of profit and loss. During the year, the company has recovered the said amount and resultantly the same is shown as other income in the statement of profit and loss.

## **Key Audit Matters**

6. Key audit matters are those matters that, in our professional judgment, were of most significance in our audit of the standalone financial statements of the current year. These matters were addressed in the context of our audit of the standalone financial statements as a whole, and in forming our opinion thereon, and we do not provide a separate opinion on these matters. We have determined that there is no key audit matters to be report during the year.

## Information other than the Standalone Financial Statements and Auditor's Report thereon

7. The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the other information. The other information comprises the information included in the annual report but does not include the financial statements and our auditor's report thereon.

Our opinion on the financial statements does not cover the other information and we do not express any form of assurance conclusion thereon.

In connection with our audit of the financial statements, our responsibility is to read the other information and, in doing so, consider whether the other information is materially inconsistent with the financial statements or our knowledge obtained in the audit or otherwise appears to be materially misstated.
