Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the consolidated financial results based on our review.

We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410, 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial results are free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of Holding company personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the Securities Exchange Board of India under Regulation 33(8) of the Listing Regulations, to the extent applicable.

These financial results have been reviewed by another auditor whose report has been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of this associate, is based solely on the reports of the other auditor and the procedures performed by us as stated above. Our conclusion on the statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.

Attention is drawn to the fact that the figures for the quarter ended 31 March 2021 as reported in this Statement are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures up to the end of third quarter of the previous financial year. 

Notes

- The statutory auditors of the company have carried out limited review of the Standalone and Consolidated Financial results for the quarter ended June 30,2021, in compliance of Regulation 33 of SEBI (LODR) regulation, 2015. The above financial results have been reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee and subsequently approved by the Board of Directors of the Company in their meeting held on 13th August, 2021.
- 2 The company's operation have also been impacted by the unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic, including the current "second wave" which resulted in an interruption in Erection & Supply activity due to nationwide lockdown. The company has made an assessment of the impact of the pandemic on its operations and the carrying value of Plant & Machinery, Inventory, Receivables and other financial assets, by relying on the internal and external sources of information and indicators of economic forecasts. Based on such assessment, the company is confident of recovering the carrying value of these assets as at June 30, 2021.

Management believes that it has taken into account all the possible impact of known events arising from COVID 19 pandemic in the preparation of the financial statements. However, the impact assessment of COVID 19 is a continuing process given the uncertainties associated with its nature and duration. The Company will continue to monitor any material changes to future economic conditions.

- 3 The Company had divested 75.09% equity investment in its wholly owned subsidiary Company, M/s Xlerate Driveline India Limited (XDIL). And now company has remained with the investment of 24.91% in XDIL. As a result of thereof, during the period XDIL has been consolidated as an Associate therefore, figures of the comparative periods are not comparable.
- The company is principally engaged in the business of Engineering contracting business. All other activities of the company revolved around the main business and accordingly, there is no separate reportable segment as per the Ind AS-108 "Operating Segment" specified under Section 133 of Companies Act, 2013.
- 5 Figures for the Quarter ended March 31, 2021 are the balancing figures between audited figures for the full financial year and the reviewed year to date figures upto the third quarter of the respective financial year.
- 6 Previous period figures have been regrouped/ reclassified wherever necessary to conform to current period classification.
